OAME/AOEM Positions

OAME/AOEM is made up of an Executive Committee and a Board of Directors. The Executive Committee consists of the President, President-Elect or Past-President, two Vice Presidents, the Executive Directors, and the Emeritus Executive member. The OAME/AOEM Board of Directors is composed of the Executive Committee, six elected Directors, Chapter Representatives, a College Representative, a University Representative, and other appointed positions (e.g. Gazette Editor, Abacus Editor, NCTM Representative, OAME/AOEM Webmaster). The members of the Board also serve on standing committees (Communications, Outreach, Curriculum, and Strategic Planning) and ad hoc committees (Technology, Advocacy, Document Management, and Conference). There are three scheduled Board meetings in October, March, and June. The Executive Committee meets monthly with most meetings happening virtually. Committee meetings (ad hoc and standing) occur regularly in between Board meetings as scheduled by the chair of each committee in order to address the work of each committee.
